The 10th International Abilympics is to be held on MAY 23 - 29, 2022.



IAF Secretariat and Abilympics National Centre of the Russian Federation with the participation of the representatives of the Government of Moscow held an online meeting on September 16, 2021.

Parties exchanged views on holding the 10th IA, discussed the issue of preparing for their National Abilympics and the possibility of organizing such online meetings regularly.

The outcomes of the meeting are the following:

- Abilympics National Centre of the Russian Federation will present the outline of the 10th IA as soon as possible.
- At the suggestion of IAF Secretariat, Abilympics National Centre of the Russian Federation will implement the second survey on the possibility of the 10th IA postponement.
- Abilympics National Centre of the Russian Federation suggested regular meeting once a month in order to embrace experience of the past IA host countries and exchange opinions.

COVID-19 COUNTERMEASURES

The Government of Moscow presented the information in regards with the measures to prevent the spread of coronavirus infection during the 10th IA.

The regulation in accordance with the strictly adopted protocol and the epidemiological statement will be organized. We will ensure that there will be very strict COVID-19 countermeasures at the venue of the event.



Disinfection

Sanitizers at the entrance of each the building, and throughout hygiene measures.



Checking body temperature

Participants with high temperature at the entrance will be taken to the medical area for further testing.



COVID-19 free zone

Only participants with the documents that prove negative COVID-19 result are allowed to enter the venue. For Russian participants, the official QR code is issued to the people who were vaccinated within six months before the event. All PCR tests are conducted within 72 hours before the event. For the foreign participants, the negative result of PCR tests within 72 hours before beginning of the event are valid and acceptable.



Masks and gloves

As the measure of preventing infection, all of the participants, volunteers, staff will be provided with masks. Currently, wearing gloves is not an obligation in Russia but we will still distribute them as the additional means of personal protection.



We will provide the utmost system of protection measures and complete package of measures against COVID-19 for participants.




The Manicurist pre-task assignment is going to be performed on human models out of countries/regions' delegations. Delegations are to bring their own models for the 10th IA.
